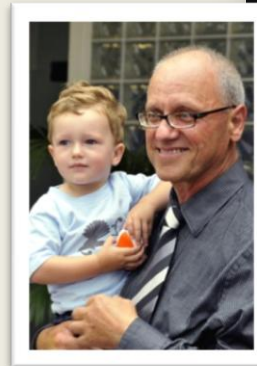
Needless to say, the Equine School has trotted off in other directions, but since then Johann has built up the School of Culinary and Hospitality to become the highly regarded centre of training it is today.
