I have been heartened by the continued support and confidence of the members who have entrusted me with the Finance Directors role. This is a very complex position incorporating legal, compliance, tax, and accounting.

I truly believe that there is no other person on the Executive that has the depth of knowledge about the constitution, and legal and financial requirements of managing the finances of the Association.

- Equipment, and logistics for Fine Food, Kiwi Kids Can Cook, International competitors, and teams.
- Culinary Olympics 2016 finance, logistics, insurances, customs and planning.
- Establishing the NZChefs Charitable Trust a project that I worked for many years to successfully register.
- I am an active member of my branch and have always supported events such as the Seafood Festival, Christmas BBQ's, Cake and Biscuit fundraising, Chefs Ball, Long Lunches, and still have energy for more!

I have undertaken professional development and am well versed in the changes in the Incorporated Societies Act, which will come into effect over the next 2 years, but for which we are preparing now.
